

Of the 444 new graduate students enrolled in Fall 2018:

- x 70 (15.8%) did not return for Spring 2019
- x 374 (84.2%) reenrolled for Spring 2019

After adjusting for graduating students, the retention rate for new graduate students was 84.2%. See Section 2, page 21 for more details. To view data for new main campus graduate students see Section 2a (p. 28) and Section 2b (p. 35) for new online graduate students.

Of the 660 continuing graduate students in Fall 2018:

- x 102 (15.5%) graduated in Fall 2018
- x 74 (11.2%) did not return for Spring 2019
- x 484 (73.3%) reenrolled for Spring 2019

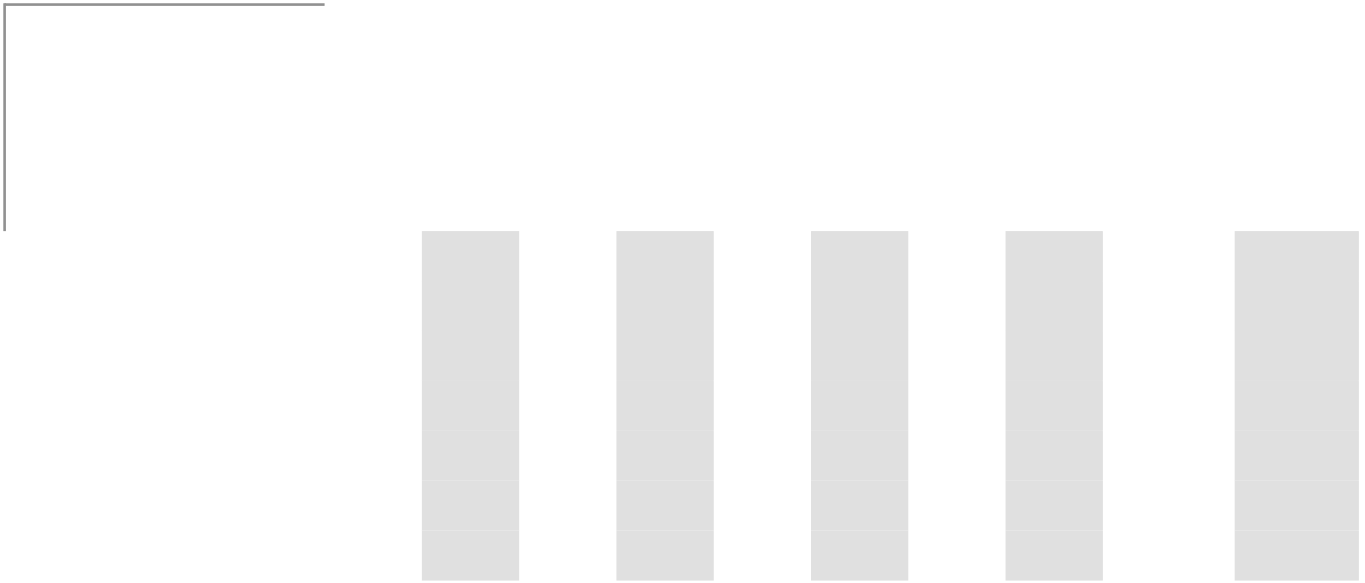

Section 3a: Continuing Graduate - Main Campus



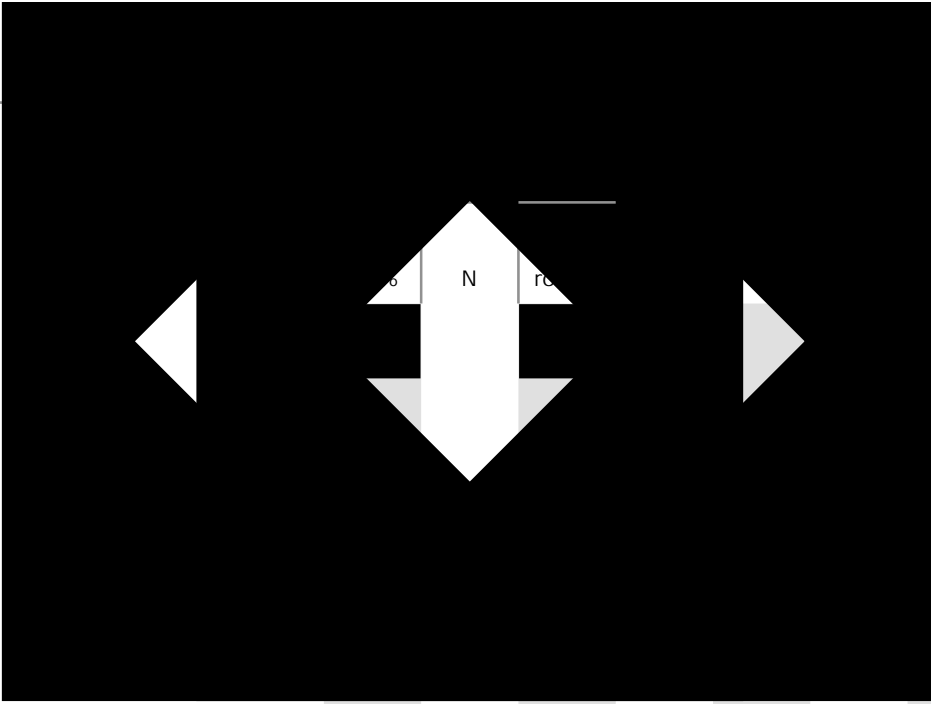
