The graduate student enrollment of 1,434 includes 503 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2022 or Fall 2022. Demographically, seventy-five percent (1,087) of the graduate students are female, and 68.1% (976) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up thirteen percent of the group. Ninety-one percent of the students are U.S. citizens.

Thirteen percent of the graduate students are classified as full-time. Fifty-seven percent are enrolled in 100% Online programs. The three largest graduate programs are the MA in Psychology, the MA in Clinical Mental Health Counseling and the MS in Nursing."

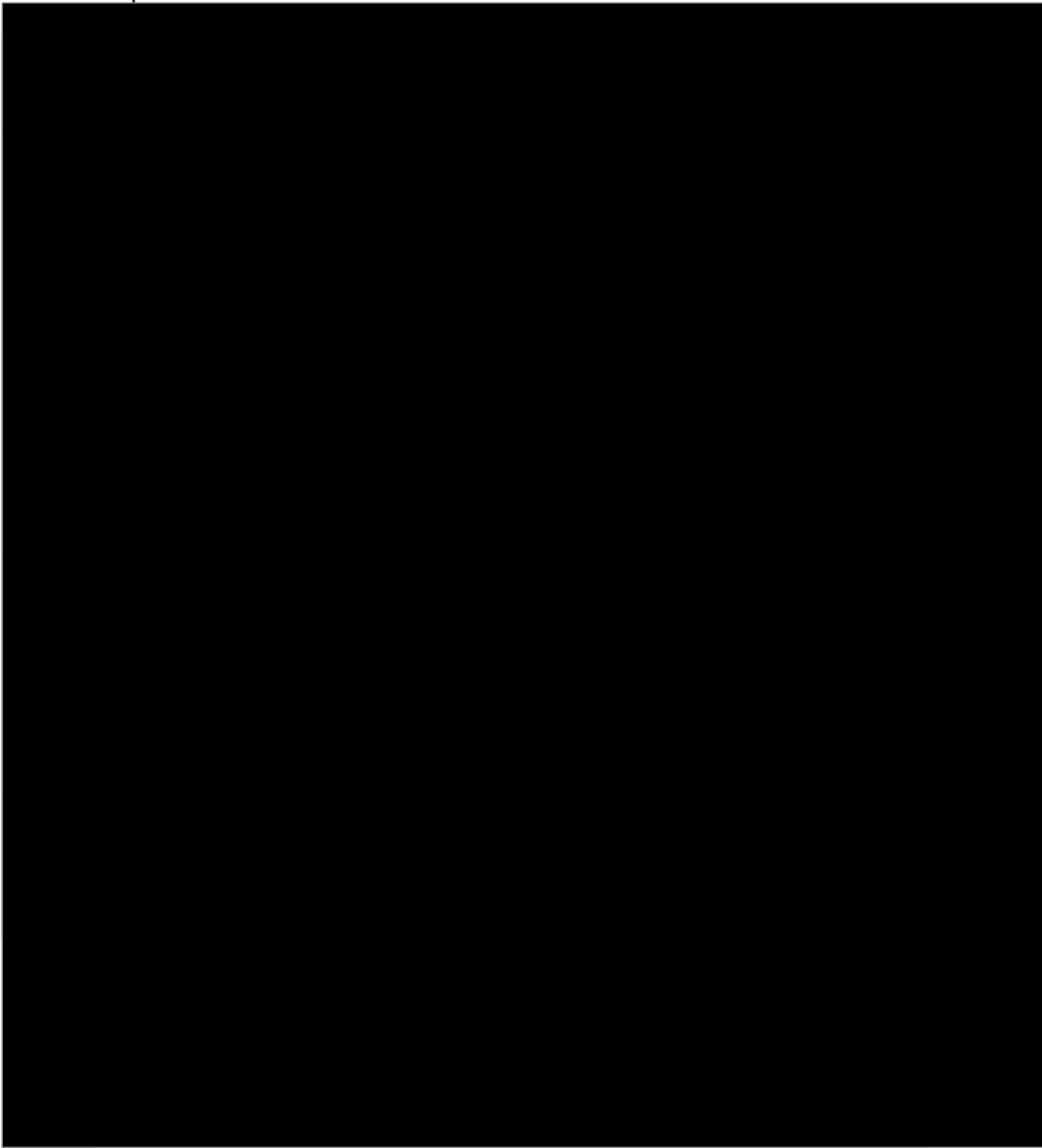
