The undergraduate enrollment of 2,823 includes 732 new freshmen and 273 new transfer students for Fall 2022. Demographically, sixty-three percent (1,778) of the undergraduates are female, and 77.5% (2,187) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up nineteen percent of undergraduates.

For students with known addresses, 2,621 (92.8%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 92 percent of students with known addresses.

The undergraduate enrollment of 2,787 includes 729 new freshmen and 239 new transfer students for Fall 2023. Demographically, sixty-two percent (1,717) of the undergraduates are female, and 75.8% (2,113) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with no declared religious preference now make up 5.8% of undergraduates.

For students with known addresses, 2,582 (92.6%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 94 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties continue to make up the majority (77.6%) of undergraduates.

Approximately 13% of undergraduates have declared Nursing as their major, while Psychology remains the second most popular major at 12% and Biology is third at 7%. Academic program distribution is otherwise consistent with last year.

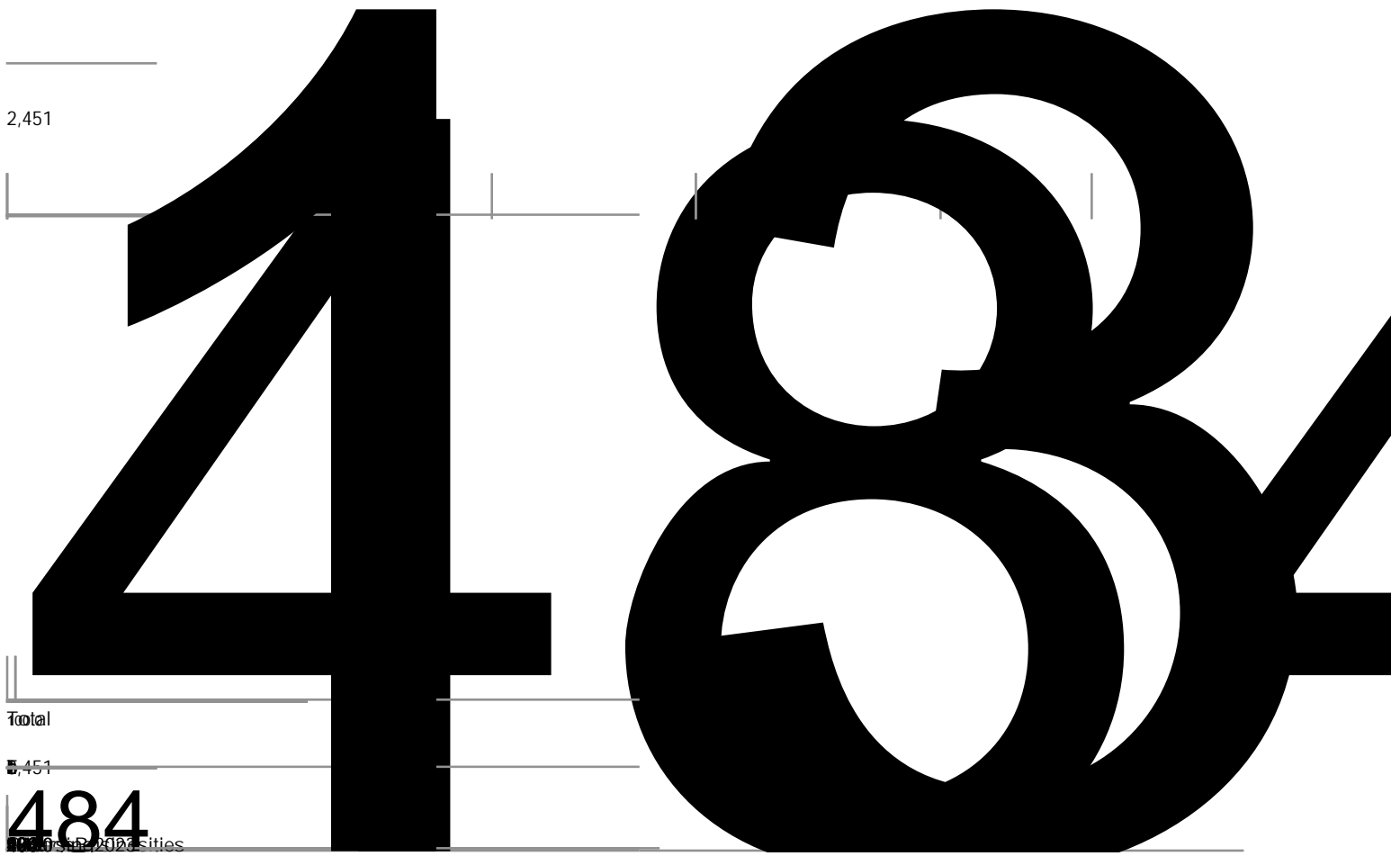
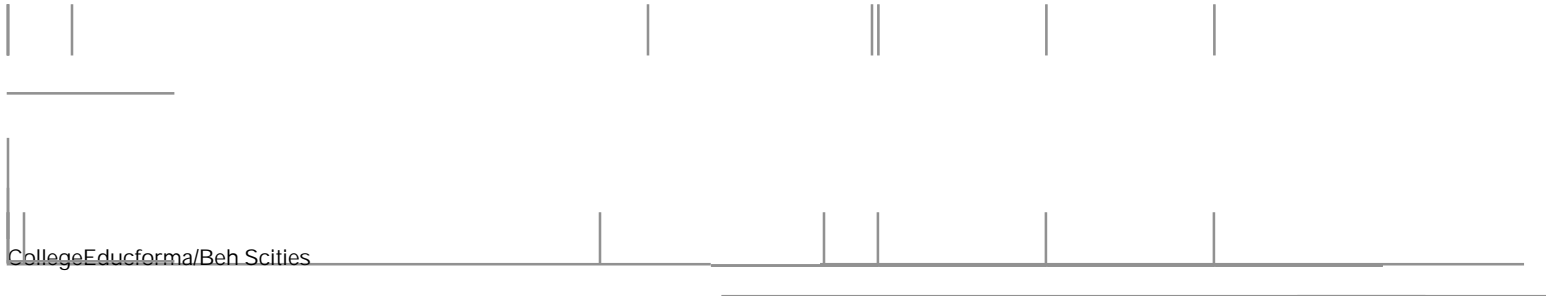
